The goal of this curriculum is to help adult education teachers and counselors guide adult learners through a comprehensive career planning process that promotes a full range of life skills.

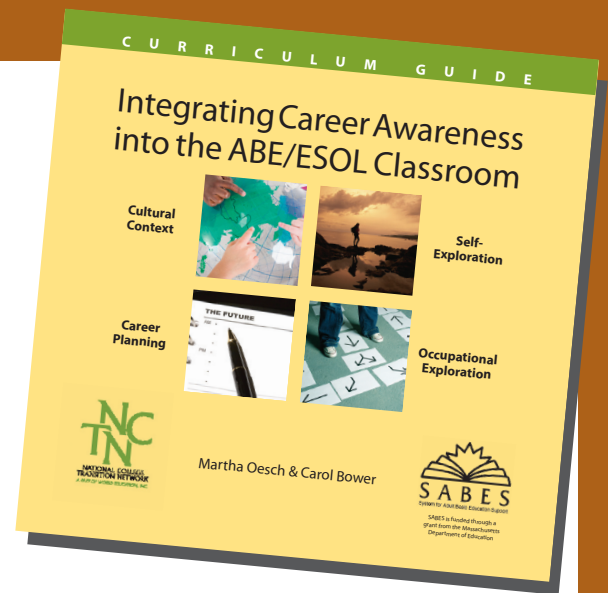
The curriculum contains lessons and classroom activities to introduce the three phases of career planning:

Self-Exploration—surveying, identifying, and highlighting one's own skills, values, experience, interests, and education.

Occupational Exploration—researching a variety of occupations through activities like reading job profiles, interviewing people working in occupations, attending career and job fairs, investigating labor market information.

Education and Career Planning—transforming the information gathered from the exploration processes into concrete decisions, goals, and action steps.

While the curriculum covers a large amount of material, it is designed to be flexible and adaptable. It can be integrated into a standard ABE, ESOL, or College Transition curriculum or evolve into a stand alone course on career awareness. The CD provides worksheets that you can download and modify as needed.
